

## **Bible Verses to Encourage Christian Writers**

1. **Psalm 45:1** – My heart is stirred by a noble theme as I recite me verses for the king; my tongue is the pen of a skillful writer. (NIV)
2. **Proverbs 18:4** – The words of a man’s mouth are like deep waters, and the fountain of skillful and godly Wisdom is like a gushing stream [sparkling, fresh, pure, and life-giving]. (AMP)
3. **Proverbs 2:6** – For the LORD gives Wisdom, and from his mouth come knowledge and understanding. (NIV)
4. **John 7:37-38** – On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, ‘Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water’.” (ESV)
5. **Isaiah 52:7** – How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, “Your God reigns!” (NIV)
6. **Proverbs 3:5-6** – Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths. (ESV)
7. **Proverbs 17:22a** – A happy hear is good medicine and a cheerful mind works healing... (AMP\_
8. **2 Timothy 2:15** – Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a workman who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth. (NIV)
9. **Jeremiah 17:5-8** – This is what the LORD says, “Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who depends on flesh for his strength and who heart turns away from the LORD. He will be like a bush in the wastelands; he will not see prosperity when it comes. He will dwell in the parched places of the desert, in a salt land where no one lives.” “But BLESSED is the man who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in Him. He will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when hear comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit.” (NIV)
10. **Galatians 6:9** – And let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we shall reap if we do not grow weary. (NASB)
11. **Jeremiah 29:11-13** – “For I know the plans that I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans for welfare and not for calamity, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me and come and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for me with all your heart.” (NASB)
12. **Hebrews 12:1** – Therefore, since we have so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us also lay aside every encumbrance, and the sin which so easily entangles us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us... (NASB)
